

Because LIFE is ALL about Second Chances

n June 7th, 2015, I was competing in the Escape from Alcatraz triathlon. Little did I know that the events of that day would have such a profound impact on my life, my career, and allow me a chance to begin again. A Second Chance.

My day began with a brisk plunge into the 55-degree waters of the San Francisco Bay, right next to the historical Alcatraz Prison. 45 minutes later, I reached land, thus completing the swim portion of the triathlon and what I assumed to be the most difficult part of my day. I was mistaken.

I mounted my bike and started the uphill journey through the mountainous streets of San Francisco. As I crested one of the streets and began racing downhill, my bike hit something, the handlebars folded, and I was

propelled from my bike onto the street traveling at 30 plus miles per hour. The next thing I remember was waking up in the hospital.

My injuries were numerous and included a concussion, road rash, strained clavicle and multiple broken bones on the right side of my face.

Two weeks after my injury, and after the swelling from my facial reconstructive surgery subsided, I was back in the operating room. I had patients who depended on me and I needed to get back on my feet again.

I believe in "second chances." No one escapes from "life" itself. I am grateful to have survived the crash and grateful did not break my neck being thrown off the bike. I thought I was invincible and could do everything I wanted. I now believe that at the lowest points of our lives, surrounded by fear, is when a breakthrough occurs. We think about what we have always wanted to do, something we wanted to try or a new skill to learn, yet somehow time got in our way.

I believe sometimes we need a wake-up call to slow us down, to pause and re-evaluate what is truly important to us. My realization was that I can make the biggest impact by being a true decision maker in a practice.

After careful reflection, I decided to setup my own practice in Scottsdale to focus on giving

others a second chance.

I know that what happened that day, as tragic as it may sound, was

my wake up call. Whether from my grandmother who recently passed to the next world, from God or something bigger than me, the message was delivered with clarity, and has certainly allowed me to look at things differently.

Someday I do want to go back to racing triathlons, I want to go back and complete that race I never finished. As for now, I will focus on a higher mission, my mission to be the best healer and educator, giving my patients a "second chance."

A "second chance" to begin again, to accomplish whatever they want in life. "

My mom was not famous, but to me, she was everything. She was the steady rock of our family.

So when my mom was diagnosed an aggressive form with inflammatory breast cancer in November 2004, my world

crumbled. We were told she probably only had 6 months to live. My mom had a fighter mentality and went in with her fist in the air ready to give it her all. She underwent surgeries, chemotherapy, radiation, scans, blood draws, doctor visits, procedures, shots, medication and more.

Defying the odds a year later, 'regular breast cancer' was found in her other breast.

Through it all, she spent time with family, encouraged others and was there to welcome 6 grandchildren.

away. The pain and ache in my heart was something I could never describe. My hero was gone.

In the summer of 2015, my sister was diagnosed with DCIS, yet another 3rd type of breast cancer. This was a 'good type of cancer to have' but deciding to treat it aggressively,

my sister had a double mastectomy with reconstruction performed by Dr. Ong.

In June 2016, during a routine visit with Dr. Liu, she informed me that due to my mom's and sister's history, my chance of getting breast cancer was 48.8%. I did not like this number. I was 34 years old, have an amazing husband and 4 young kids. I couldn't lose it all to breast cancer. I didn't want to go get a ultrasound, mammogram, MRI every 6 months for the rest of my life, waiting to see if this was the time I would get bad news. To make it worse, the imaging facility was next door to the hospice where my mom died.

So, I came to talk to Dr. Ong about what reconstruction would look like following a preventative double mastectomy. She sat with me for over a hour, talking about my health history and asked how I was doing mentally and emotionally. She listened, encouraged and gave me some things to think about in the decision making process. I knew from my sister's previous surgery with Dr. Ong, she could make me

look and feel amazing. With the support of my husband and family, I chose to have a preventative double mastectomy with immediate reconstruction in August of 2016. With the amazing skills and state of the art care given to me by Dr. Ong, my recovery time, healing and pain was manageable.

Dr. Ong closely monitored me and took great care of me into my recovery process. I was given a second chance. I am humbled to walk into a 'cancer center' for follow up, knowing that my pathology report was negative. I have sat there to hear heart wrenching news, so I do not take for granted the days of health and love I have been given. In the continued grief process of my mom, I am sad, but no longer have to fear that I will be next to hear the words 'breast cancer.' Instead. I can live enjoying my husband and children knowing that I made decisions to protect us all from agony of breast cancer.

My second chance allows me to dream big for the future and wait to see what it will hold.
